- **First lessons**: the lecture will start Monday 16th March. The first lessons will be recorded (audio and video) and will be put on-line. The lecture will continue normally in Room 2AB45, as soon as the University opens again.

- Structure of the course: The course will be in English. The teacher will illustrate a wide range of problems and ideas in the Calculus of Variation. A very important part of the course will be the homeworks. There will be 4 or 5 "Exercises sheets" with problems to solve. The first one will be at the beginning of April. The student is invited to work on these exercises. After a couple of weeks he can return his solutions to the teacher. This is not obligatory, this is a choice of the student.
- **Exam**: The student has two options:
  - 1) He can return his solutions to the homeworks (paper sheets or pdf are both fine). At the end of the lecture, the teacher will propose a final grade based on the correction of the homeworks.
  - 2) Alternatively, the student can take an oral exam on the program of the course.
