- Structure of the course: The course will be in English with lectures at the blackboard. The teacher will illustrate a wide range of problems and ideas in the Calculus of Variations. Homeworks will be a very important part of the course. There will be 4 or 5 "Exercises sheets" with problems to solve. The student is invited to work on these exercises and after a couple of weeks he can return his solutions. This is not obligatory, this is a choice of the student.
