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## Right Inverses of linear maps on convex sets

A continuous linear surjective map of Banach spaces is an open mapping, and by Michael's theorem it has then continuous right inverses. But the restriction of such a map to a non open convex subset of the domain is in general no longer open, and the associated fiber multifunction has in general no continuous selection.
